### **Compensation Methodology**

The annual compensation for SOAH's Chief Administrative Law Judge is set as a line-item exempt position in Article VIII of the General Appropriations Act. The Governor determines the salary of the Chief Administrative Law Judge. SOAH, under the leadership of the Chief Administrative Law Judge, follows the State Classification Plan in determining the compensation for all classified employees, which includes executive staff.

#### **Salary Supplements**

The agency's executive staff are not eligible for a salary supplement as described in Section 659.0201 or 659.026(a) (1) of the Texas Government Code.
